# **Healthy Reserve Fund**


- \$589,901 as of Dec. 31, 2021








#### **Parish Income – 5 Year Changes**







The majority of groups at St. Philip's are active, although a significant minority are on hold due to the pandemic.




#### Current Ministries = 67




Which of the following pictures best describes how you feel about leading a ministry at the moment?

Ministry Leaders remain optimistic about their mission and the future.






